- Go to http://www.ctan.org/tex-archive/fonts/skull/ and download the files there (there's a handy .zip file at the top).
- Go to http://www.tex.ac.uk/cgi-bin/texfaq2html?label=instpackages+ wherefiles and follow the directions from there.
 - 22 Run LATEX on the .ins file. This will generate a .sty package file.
 - **2** Run LATEX on the .dtx file (possibly twice to get the index to work correctly). This will supposedly give you documentation and a manual, though it didn't work for me.
