

CS 124 Investigation 5 Grading Rubric

Initial Prototype (5 points)

- ___ 2pts: High-fidelity in look. Care was taken to create a final-looking interface.
- ___ 1pt: Medium-fidelity in feel. Attempts were made to account for any interactions that could not be modeled with an image-based prototype.
- ___ 2pts: Medium-fidelity in breadth. Prototype supports all three tasks and all major screens and dialogs are present.

Usability problems (3 points)

- ___ 1pt: Completeness/organization. Several usability problems present, ranked in order of decreasing severity.
- ___ 2pts: Severity ratings seem appropriate for usability problem.

Redesign (3 points)

- ___ 1pt: Significant number of usability problems addressed.
- ___ 1pt: Redesign decisions clearly solve usability problems
- ___ 1pt: New prototype complete. Design responds to redesign decisions listed above.

Reflection (4 points) INDIVIDUAL

- ___ 3pts: Quality of reflection:
 - 0 pts = reflections missing or shows no thought
 - 1 pt = reflection is superficial or shows minimal thought/understanding
 - 2 pts = reflection shows a moderate understanding of the process of interaction design. Basic understanding of the utility of prototyping techniques/task analysis/etc. Some thought about what to do differently.
 - 3 pts = reflection shows a deep understanding of interaction design including a deep understanding of what each stage and type of prototyping is good for and when and why each should be used. Well-reasoned arguments for what to do differently in the design process.
- ___ 1pt: Text is well-written and structured. No wordy sentences or grammatical errors. Points are clear. No superfluous text. No pieces of assignment missing.
